

HOW TO CHANGE THE GFCI CASING


In order to change the casing of a defective GFCI plug, follow these steps:

REQUIRED PARTS

You will need:


- New GFCI plug
- A screwdriver


Parts are available from your local retailer.



1 Make sure that the length of the drawn wire matches the illustration:








- 2 The wires have a specific position according to their color:

 - A. The yellow screw black/blkB. The green screw green/grnC. The silver screw -white/wht



3 Place one wire at a time in its position, according to the color.


Be careful, each wire must be insertedto the very bottom;



4 Tighten each screw;










5 Add the metal plate and screw. Make sure to put it on the right side as above:









6 Make sure the small pad is placed against the panel and close the plug;
